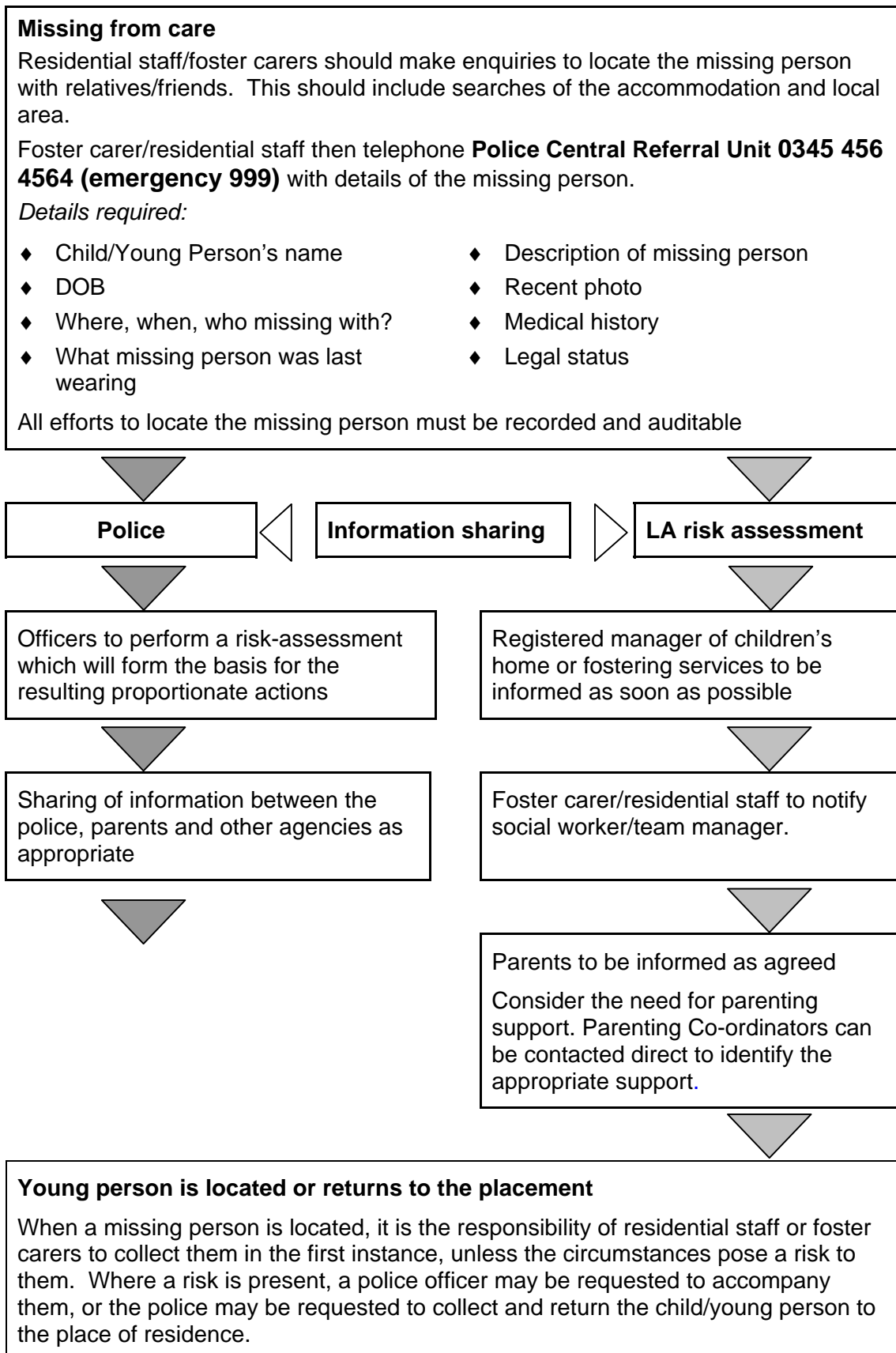
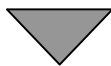


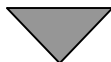
APPENDIX 4: Young people missing from care process flowchart





The police will conduct a **Safe and Well Check** young person's return to establish the missing person's well-being, and to establish whether they were the victim of crime or abuse whilst missing

Consider the benefit of parenting support for foster carers. Parenting Co-ordinators can be contacted to identify the appropriate support.

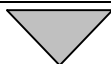


Foster carer/residential staff to:

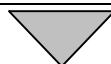
- ◆ Provide positive non-judgemental return;
- ◆ Check young person's medical condition and make necessary arrangements



Placement staff to inform the social worker and team manager of the person's return



Arrangements for **Return Interview (within 72 hours of return) by an 'independent' person** to be agreed in consultation with the child/young person.
Care plan to be updated.



Consider whether to:

- ◆ Convene a multi-agency strategy meeting;
- ◆ Arrange an early looked-after child review;
- ◆ Review any prevention/support work currently being undertaken with the child/young person
