

<p>Emerging Risk</p> <p>Non-specific/uncorroborated specific information</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Places... Some evidence or concern of potential risk or danger in a location due to environmental hazards, community concerns or safety issues. • Peers. Some concerns that there a peer group that is having a negative impact. At this stage the peer group may be unknown • Persons of Interest (adult) Some concerns that the child/young person may be associating with yet unknown adults who may present a risk.
<p>Moderate Risk</p> <p>Specific/corroborated information</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Places Evidence/disclosure suggests that there is a potential of risk or danger at a specific location due to environmental hazards, community concerns or safety issues. • Peers Some concerns that there is a known peer group which is having a negative impact. • Persons of Interest (adult) Some concerns that the child/young person is associating with known adults who may be having a negative impact on their wellbeing.
<p>Significant Risk</p> <p>Specific/corroborated information which identifies risk of significant harm.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Places Evidence / disclosure suggests that there is an immediate and / or continuing risk or danger associated with a known location due to environmental hazards, community concerns, safety issues. • Peers Evidence of immediate concerns that there is a known peer group having a negative impact and increasing the risk to others and locations. • Persons of Interest (adult) Evidence of immediate concerns that the child/young person is associating with known adult(s) which is significantly affecting their wellbeing.
